The National American Sign Language Honor Society (ASLHS) is pleased to announce the Fall 2019 Chuck Baird Memorial Art Competition. The following instructions and forms provide the necessary information to participate in the competition. To participate, students must attend a school with a current ASLHS chapter on campus.

DEAF POP ART

Reproduction:

- The artwork shall be any Ann Silver reproduction of a Deaf person and by a Deaf artist.
- A source of the original artwork being reproduced must be included to be used as a comparison. (This can be a website reference or a print off of the artwork)
- The artwork can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, charcoal, acrylic, oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the internet are not acceptable.

Original Creation:

- The Deaf Pop Art shall be any art based on everyday items that reflects the Deaf experience..
- The artwork can be created in the following mediums: watercolor, colored pencils, crayons, markers, charcoal, acrylic oil, and pencil sketch.
- The artwork must be entirely of the student's own creation. Clipart or images taken from the Internet are not acceptable.

8. Registration Forms

The ASL teacher is responsible for coordinating the completion of all registration forms. There are 4 forms that need to be filled out:

1. Competition cover sheet, filled out by the teacher (Print and include a hard copy or email);
2. School Entry Form, electronic copy filled out by the teacher (Included on the USB drive or email);
3. Payment form, filled out by the teacher (Print and include a hard copy); **mailed to ASLTA Treasurer, PO Box 64801 Rochester, NY 14624**
4. Student Entry form, filled out by the student (Print and include a hard copy or email).

9. Prizes & Certificates

- Winners will be decided by renowned Deaf Artist **Ann Silver**
- All students will receive a certificate of participation.
- Entries whose works are considered as a Finalist will receive a GOLD seal. Entries whose works are considered in the top will receive a SILVER seal.
- Classroom will receive a certificate of participation
- Monetary prizes, for both categories, are as follows:
 - First place: \$100.00
 - Second place: \$75.00
 - Third place: \$50.00
- Winning students and teachers will receive a signed ASL art print from Ann Silver.

10. Announcement of Winners

Winners will be announced **December 5, 2019**, on the ASL Honor Society website. If your student wins in any category, you will be informed prior to the announcement.

11. Winning Entries

Winning entries will be posted on the ASL Honor Society's webpage. **It is essential that any student under 18 years of age have a parent or guardian's permission to have their child's entry posted.** This information appears on the student's entry form.

12. Return of USB Drives

All submissions become the property of ASLHS and will not be returned, so please make a backup copy of all entries. USB drives can be returned if you include return postage.

What is Deaf Pop Art?

Deaf pop art is an artistic, emotional, and visual expression that focuses on the Deaf experience. This art form combines visual elements, mannerisms, codes, and imagery that are associated with the Deaf and ASL. Language, culture, history, politics, and society are some of the themes reflected in this medium.

Who is Ann Silver?

Ann Silver is a Deaf Pop artist. Using different medias, she shows the oppression of the Deaf and sign language. Much like Andy Warhol, she uses everyday objects, such as Kellogg's cornflake boxes, Crayola boxes, and license plates to mimic and critique the hearing world's stereotypes of the Deaf. Ann Silver is one of the founding artists in the Deaf Artist Movement DAM in the 60s and 70s.
